We want to generate a mosaic, a patchwork quilt of ideas, experiences, images, sensations; a personal, intimate diary about what we are living, which allows us to perceive illness,

We use the concept of a postcard, like the one we would send to a friend telling them what we are excited about. We want a short and personal text for digital publication that tells a story or makes a reflection and/or an essay of one to ten photographs, and/or one or more drawings or illustrations. The themes can be as diverse as loneliness, waiting, gratitude, the urgency to rescue eroticism, the importance of culture in these times of crisis, confinement, the economy, inequality, the effects of disease, personal and collective vulnerability, environmental causes and effects, history or science, what we took for granted and now we can not enjoy etc, etc. They can be intellectual or artistic reflections. The idea is to build a collective diary with diverse perspectives and sensibilities. All submitted work should not have been published in digital or paper media or personal networks.
