OAR is an institution of Christian inspiration of the socialist Cuban society, with a macro-ecumenic projection that contributes to social development from an egalitarian

The Center Oscar Arnulfo Romero is a non profit organization that promotes solidarity, the acknowledgement of Cuba in the international scene and contributes to the integral education of men and women interested in personal and social growth through the promotion of spaces of research, improvement and analysis in order to create a sustainable society. The youth articulation for social justice from OAR, Oscar Arnulfo Romero Center, is conceived as a common workspace, promotion, and activism. Created in May 8th, 2016, its participants's differences in background it's what makes it unique. Differences in terms of place of birth, education, work experience, sexual orientation, gender identity, residency, color of skin, religious practices, and life expectancies. The coordinators board aims to articulate networks, initiatives, and projects that focus on diverse subjects. Its work is targeted to 18 to 35 years old folks specially in schools and communities. Its uses the Popular Education methodology where practical and theoretical knowledge about social justice is shared with an emphasis in gender and human rights. This continuous work generates skills that allow them to execute their civil rights, having a personal opinion, come up with strategies for social change, and to connect with other activists in order to gain relevance in the promotion of social justice in their contexts (work, family, school, and community). Lo distintivo es la diversidad de sus integrantes en cuanto a procedencia, t3rminos de 3mbitos de estudio y trabajo, orientaci3n er3tico afectiva, identidad de g3nero, lugar de residencia, color de la piel, pr3cticas o no religiosas, experiencias y expectativas de vida, etc. Desde la coordinaci3n, se intenciona la articulaci3n de redes, iniciativas, proyectos de diferentes tem3ticas; sustentado en el trabajo con y para j3venes entre 18 y 35 a3os, cuyo accionar se da fundamentalmente en escuelas y comunidades. Se trabaja con la metodolog3a de la Educaci3n Popular, en un proceso formativo te3rico pr3ctico donde se les comparten a sus integrantes conocimientos y herramientas relacionadas con la equidad social, colocando el 3nfasis en la dimensi3n g3nero y los derechos humanos, de esta forma desarrollan competencias que puestas en pr3ctica, les permiten el ejercicio aut3nomo de sus derechos, la defensa de sus criterios, el dise3o de propuestas de transformaci3n social y la articulaci3n con otros actores sociales, para que tengan mayor protagonismo en la promoci3n de equidad social en sus contextos locales (laborales, familiares, escolares y comunitarios).



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
