An approach and a forum for discussion and collaboration among the forest community and local development agencies, the Model Forest (CANADA) makes it possible to reconcile the ecological, social, cultural and economic needs of a region. In a Model Forest, a variety of people with differing interests and perspectives form a partnership to develop new natural resources management tools that reflect their history, economic situation and cultural identity in a way that does not jeopardize future generations. Thousands of kilometres separate them, but the Lac-Saint-Jean Model Forest (LSJMF) and its Cameroon Model Forests counterparts â€" Dja et Mpomo, Campo Ma'an â€"are forging ties to develop the Cameroon economy. The two regions are united in a common cause, that of building a forest-based economy through collective management of their resources.
